

# Missional Meals Mentoring

We provide coaching cohorts for the 6 weeks surrounding the launch of a new Community Meal based church. We share best practices and wrestle with problems that arise during our launches.

Missional Meals mentoring includes free “long term” availability via phone or FaceTime as needed.

Mentoring sessions will include a short teaching with actionable application and accountability. Topics include:

- Finding the right “place”
- Locating a person of peace
- Developing your team
- Helping the “sending church” get it
- Questions that come along the way
